



# How to check fonts in your PDF file

To make a PDF file that does not include 16-bit font, you have to know if your PDF file includes 16-bit code. To find what font is included in your PDF file, please look at the following instructions.

(1) Open a PDF file with your Acrobat reader program.



(2) Pull down the “File Menu” and find a “Property” tab.



(3) When you pick the **property tab**, you will see a property window of the PDF file. Then, find a **Font tab** and pick it. Then you can see a **list of fonts** that are used in the PDF file.

(4) It often happens that we can't find any 16-bit character code in the main text of the paper. In the case, you should check your figures. Figures often include 16-bit code and you might have un-intentionally included the font in the PDF file.

It is said that some drawing software automatically includes 16-bit font code in the figure unless you specify the default font to 8-bit font.
